Technique Classes

Class	Description	Dates offered
Beginning Quilting- A la Carte	If you ever wanted to make a quilt and had no idea where to start, we have the solution for you. These comprehensive machine piecing classes are geared to beginners and those wishing to improve their piecing skills. Everyone ends up with an attractive quilt. Each class is priced separately or you can sign up for all 6 classes for a special price of \$100. <i>Teacher: Muriel Pfaff</i>	
Plan Your Quilt	This class is designed for beginning quilters who are overwhelmed by selecting fabric for their quilt. We will spend time in the shop selecting fabrics that will make your quilt a visual success. Class will focus on theme fabrics and complementary colors that will add texture and "pop". 1-2hour class \$20 (This session is free if you enroll in entire series)	Mon Sept 11 10am
Cut It Up	Learn basic rotary cutting techniques and safety skills. You will cut the fabric for a lap size quilt in this class. 1-2 hour class \$20	Mon Sept 18 10am
Sew It Up	Learn machine piecing and how to assemble pre-cut quilt pieces. Attending the "Cut It Up" class or basic knowledge of rotary cutting is required, as your pieces are cut before class. Class will focus on piecing Nine Patch blocks and Half Square Triangles. 1- 3 hour class \$30	Mon Sept 25 10am
Square It Up	Make sure your patchwork blocks are perfectly square with the technique you'll learn here. Once your blocks are all the same size, you'll piece the quilt top together. 1 - 2 hour class \$20	Mon Oct 2 10am
Border It Up	Having trouble getting quilts to lay flat? This problem will be solved by using the techniques for applying borders and sashing taught in this class. This class will focus on attaching borders to your pre-sewn top. 1 - 2 hour class \$20	Mon July 10 6pm, Oct 9 10am
Quilt It Up	After you have cut your fabrics and sewn your blocks together... this class shows you how to mark and machine quilt a lap size quilt. Learn about batting and basting (including "spray basting") and then begin quilting your top. 1 - 3 hour class \$25	Mon July 17 6pm Oct 16 10am
Beyond Beginner	This class is designed for those who have finished their first quilt and are eager to learn more! Brush up on your piecing skills while working on a sampler quilt and learning techniques for making Quarter Square Triangles, Flying Geese, Square-in-a-Square blocks and more. Learn simple design and setting techniques including sashings, straight set, on point set and medallion set – each student will select their own quilt setting. Size of quilt made in class will depend on the setting chosen. Beginning/Intermediate Paper Piecing	Let Debbie Schneider show you the first steps in learning to paper piece using noted quilter Judy Niemeyer and Jacqueline DeJonge's techniques. Binding Your Quilt	Learn the secrets of continuous double-fold binding, crisp corners, machine or hand finishes. Muriel Pfaff will show you options. Turn your sample into a cute 3-pocket purse. Collage Class	Explore the Collage technique by beginning a small piece . . . an 18x22" collage "mini quilt" with a pineapple design (pattern provided). It's Kindergarten art class . . . with sharper scissors and fabric is our medium! We'll cover fabric selection, fusing and cutting motifs, choosing the perfect background, and putting your personal stamp on every project.
